### SCHOOL SICK BAY MEDICATION

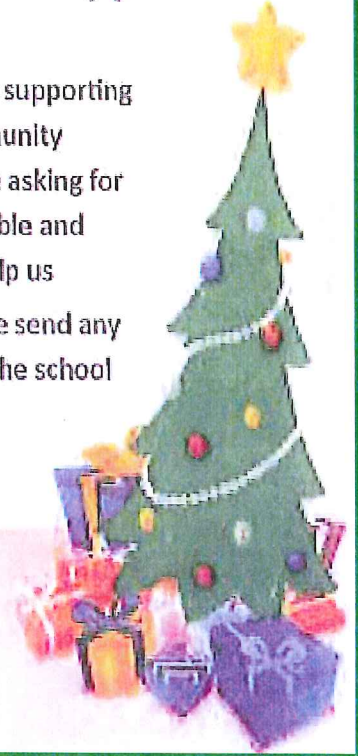
Any medication not collected from Sick Bay will be disposed of at the end of the school year.
